Aluminium & Tin Cans



Separate the different colors: white, brown, and green.
Green also includes any other color

Where?

Public collection sites or main recycling station





What?

Paper

including newspapers, envelopes, magazines, and brochures as long they are uncoated



Where?

Street collection (separate day from Cardboard)

Collection dates can be found on your town's collection calendar.

On the indicated day, you need to bring the paper out by 7am.



Make sure you tie the paper together with a string like on the photo below.

Street collection (separate day from Paper)

Collection dates can be found on your town's collection calendar.

On the indicated day, you need to bring the cardboard out by 7am.

Collections site for organics
(ask your landlord if this is available at your property)



Practical “compo-bag” can be bought at the supermarket. Please do not use any type of plastic bag

Any other household rubbish

Where?

Rubbish bags/stamps from your municipality or



Sold at every grocery store. Ask for them at the till, as you will not find them on any shelf.

Important

Every district and municipality has a slightly different system, so make sure you buy the bags in a shop in your local area.
